## TURF TALK BY TRAVIS (PRE-EMERGENT HERBICIDDES)

Smithfields Members - I am going to change things a bit in my monthly article and bring awareness to certain agronomic practices that we do on the golf course and why we do them. Each month I am going to pick a topic and write a brief overview of what it does and why we use it. I thought this month I would start with pre-emergent herbicides since we are right in the window of making those applications.
Pre-emergent herbicides are designed to control weeds before their seeds have a chance to germinate and establish. They work by creating a barrier at or near the soil surface, preventing the growth of new weed seedlings while causing minimal harm to the established plants. They do this by inhibiting root development and stopping the weeds from breaking the soil surface.
We apply pre-emergent herbicides twice a year to prevent summer and winter weeds such as Crabgrass and annual Bluegrass and other broadleaf weeds. Our biggest challenge here is Virginia Buttonweed. Unfortunately, Virginia Buttonweed, once established, does not come back each year from seed so pre-emergent herbicides have very little effect on preventing it. Pre-emergent herbicides are extremely important when maintaining large areas of fine turf by managing weed problems before they start and ensuring a uniform and healthy turfgrass stand.

## GOLFTIP OFTHE MONTH!

We will be hosting 4 demo days over the course of about 45 days and companies will be bringing their TRACKMANS to do the custom club fittings. TRACKMAN has a feature called the "Optimizer" and it allows the club fitter to tell if your current club is the optimum fit for you or if there is another club that can be more optimal or better fit to gain you more distance.

The "Optimizer" will measure Spin loft, Ball Speed, Launch Angle, Spin Rate, Height of Shot, Carry, Total Distance, Club Head Speed, Smash Factor and about 20 other parameters. It will precisely tell you if any of these parameters are too high or too low and how much total distance it is costing you. It is not uncommon to see players having the wrong club or type of shaft and losing 10-30 yards on some or all of their clubs. See the example to the right that is costing a player 21 yards off the tee - Sign up for a demo day and see if we can't help you "Optimize" your game in 2024!!!
